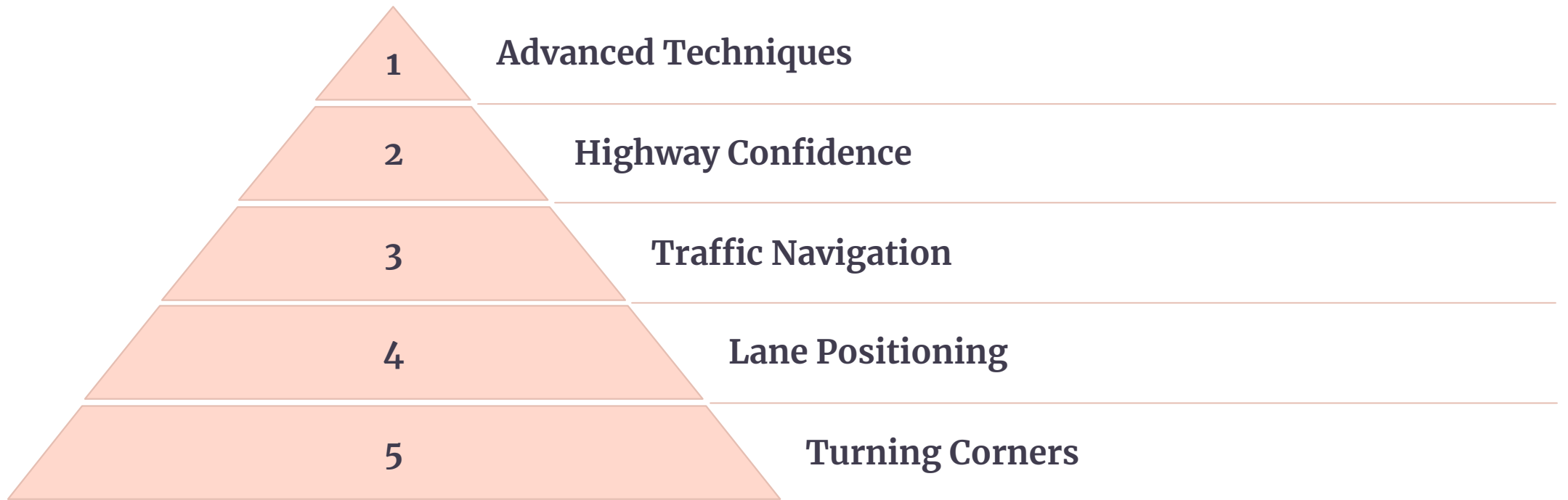

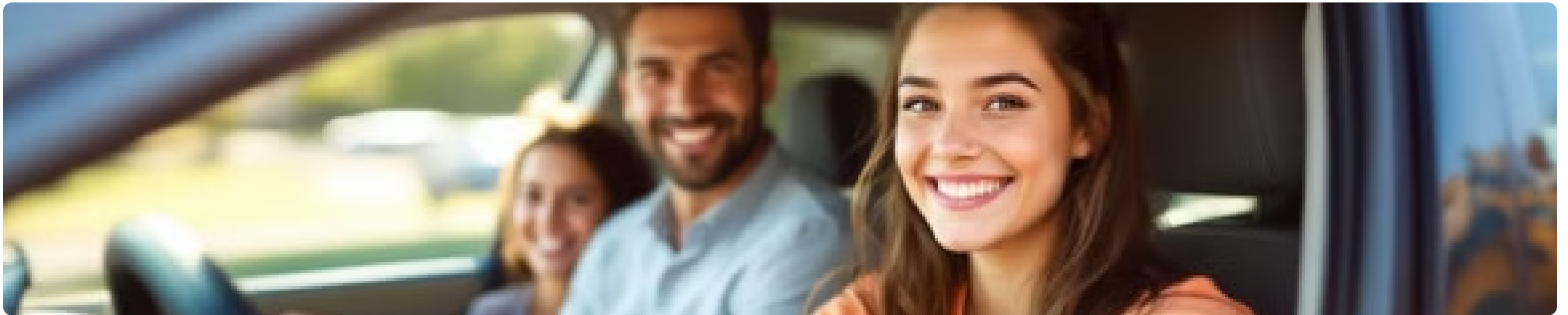
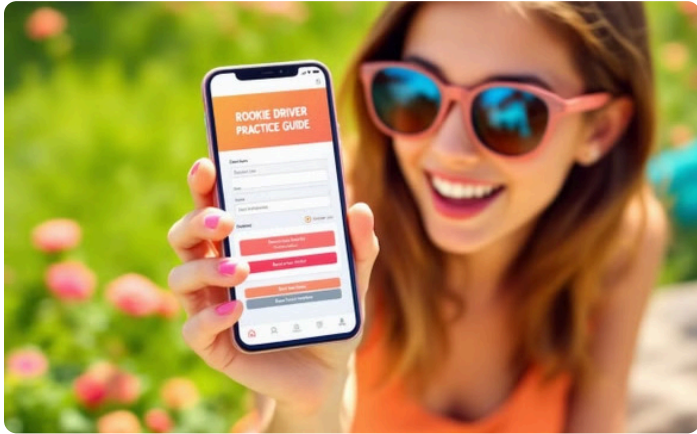


Specific Skills in Personalized Lessons
